ORDER PARTIALLY GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR SUPPLEMENTAL ACCOUNTING AND DENYING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

UPON CONSIDERATION of plaintiff's exceptions filed on June 27, 1973, to the General Services Administration's accounting report of March 25, 1969, filed by the defendant, and of the plaintiff's motion, also of June 27, 1973, to require the defendant to file supplemental accounting information; considering the defendant's response thereto and the defendant's motion to dismiss for lack of jurisdiction as to all matters arising after August 13, 1946; considering also the plaintiff's responses thereto, and consistently with the opinion herein,

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for supplemental accounting information be allowed, in accordance with the opinion herein, as to Exceptions 1, 6, 7, and 10. The defendant is directed to submit its response to these exceptions within 90 days of this order. The plaintiff may amend its exceptions within 30 days thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for supplemental accounting be denied as to Exceptions 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 9, without prejudice to the plaintiff's seeking additional information by interrogatories where appropriate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant's motion to dismiss for lack of jurisdiction be, and hereby is, denied.
