FINAL AWARD

Upon the Joint Motion for Entry of Final Judgment filed by the parties herein on February 5, 1974, pursuant to a stipulation for entry of final judgment filed with said motion, the Commission considered the evidence presented, both oral and written, at a hearing called for that purpose on February 8, 1974.

The Commission, having this day entered Findings of Fact which are hereby made a part of this order, concludes as a matter of law that the proposed settlement of the plaintiff's accounting claim is equitable and just to both parties and that a final award should be entered in accordance with the stipulation.




