ORDER DISMISSING CLAIMS

Upon the Findings of Fact and Opinion this date entered herein and which are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that:

- 1. Neither the Cree nor the Chippewa Indians nor any band or group of Cree or Chippewa Indians ever exclusively used and occupied any portion of the claimed area.
- 2. The plaintiffs have failed to prove any title interest in the claimed lands, and the above captioned claims must be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the claim entitled second claim (relating to land in the State of Montana) in Docket 191, as set forth in paragraphs 18 through 20 of the petition, and the claims in Docket 221-B, be, and the same are hereby, dismissed.
