FINAL AWARD

Upon the findings of fact numbered 1 through 31, heretofore entered in the case at bar, the opinions issued concurrently with said findings of fact, the additional findings of fact numbered 32 through 44 and the opinion this date issued herein, all of which are incorporated in this final award, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that:

- 1. The amount of \$76,191.35 should be deducted from the interlocutory award \$1,100,000.00) in this case as a payment on the claim.
- 2. The defendant is not allowed to offset any gratuitous expenditures against the award in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that as a final award the Bois Forte Band of Chippewa Indians have and recover from the defendant the sum of \$1,023,808.65 in full satisfaction of all claims in Docket 18-D.
